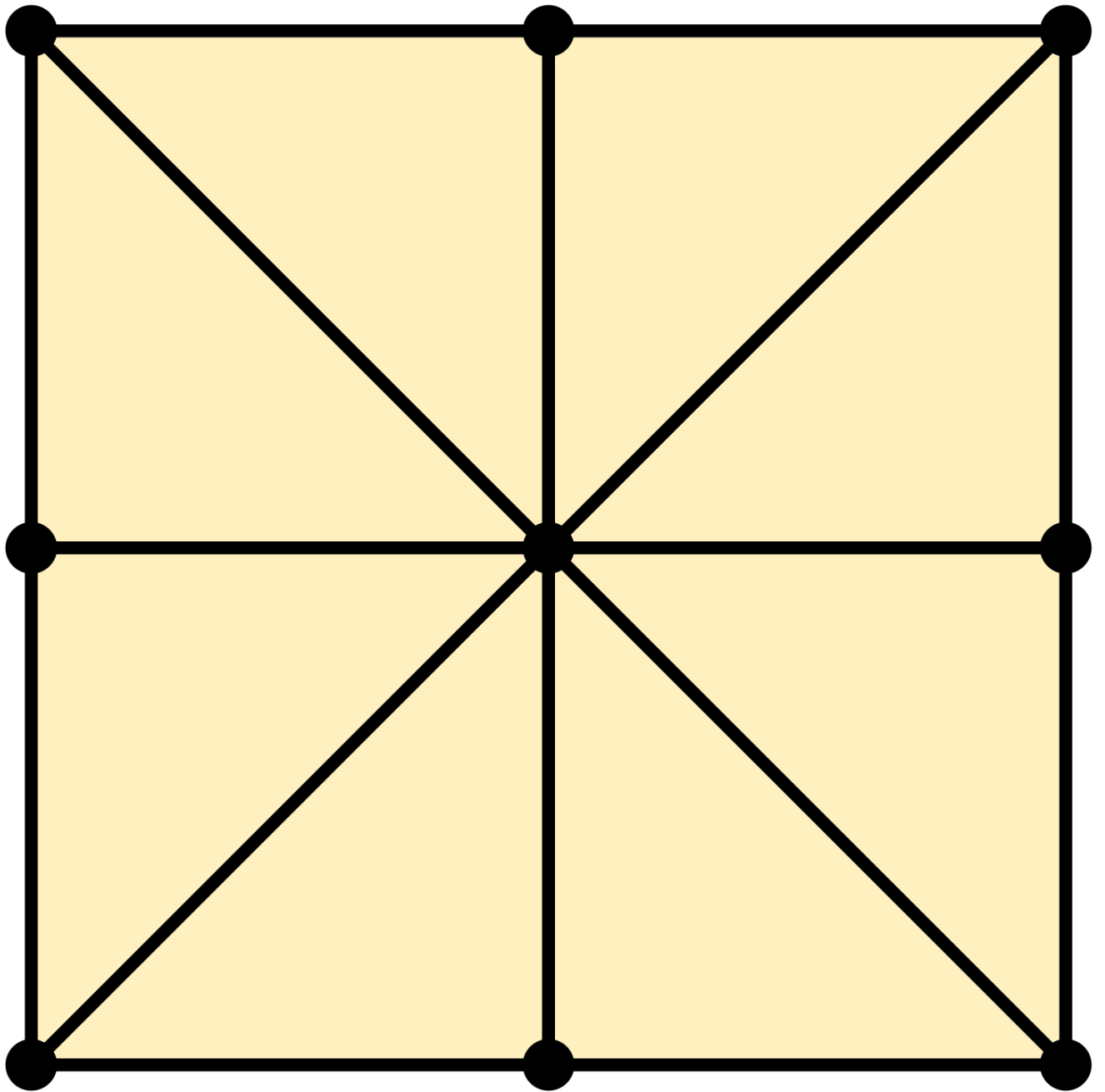


THE GAME  
OF THREE  
MEN'S  
MORRIS





# Rules:

- You will need six playing pieces – three for each person, with each player having a different colour of playing piece.
- The rules are very simple! You are trying to make a row (in a straight line, but in any direction!) of your three pieces.
- The first player puts a piece on the board at one of the nine positions where lines join. The second player does the same –and tries to stop the first player making a row!
- The first player then goes again; then the second; the first again; then the second, each remembering to try to stop their opponent from making a row.
- By now, either one person has made a row of three (congratulations – they have won!) ... or neither have made a row of three.
- If neither have made a row of three, the first player can now move any of their pieces to an adjacent (next-door – in any direction!) empty position.
- Still no row of three? Carry on, each player taking turns to move any piece to an empty adjacent position, until someone succeeds!
